2015 Summer and Fall Admitted UCF Knights

- You may have received communication or have learned about a requirement called Honor Your Knighthood.
- Involves completing four separate/individual on-line modules: Hazing Prevention, Academic Integrity, Alcohol EDU, and Not Anymore.
- These four programs **DO NOT have to be completed by your scheduled orientation date.**
- Completion of these four programs are **NOT associated with an inability to receive financial aid awards or registering for classes during orientation.**
- We encourage you though to complete these four programs in a timely manner in association with deadlines determined.
- Please be aware that each program has a unique date in which the program is available to complete (start date) and a unique deadline date as well.
- You will receive **notification of these programs on your To-Do-List** associated with your myUCF
 - The requirement is **not automatically removed from a to-do-list after successful completion** of the module
 - Student information is sent on a weekly basis to the registrar's office to have the requirement removed from their to-do-lists
 - **Allow at least two to three weeks for the requirement to be removed** from a to-do-list

How to Access the AlcoholEdu Modules

- Access Date: Monday, July 27, 2015
- Students will be prompted through notification on their to-do-list/myUCF page:
 1. Log in to the myUCF portal
 2. Click the HEALTH link on the left side of the page
 3. Click on the AlcoholEdu link
 4. For successful completion, students must score an 80 or better on part one
 5. 45 days after successfully completing the first module, students will receive an email notification to complete part two

How is the AlcoholEdu Module Removed from To-Do-Lists?

- Must receive a score of 80% or higher on both sections to consider the module successfully completed
- Part one and part two (both sections) must be completed before the requirement will be removed from a student's to-do-list

Due Dates for the AlcoholEdu Modules

- Part One – Monday, August 24, 2015 (complete all sections in part one and complete the exam)
- Part Two – Monday, November 11, 2015 (complete all sections in part two and complete the exam)

How to Access the Not Anymore Modules

- Access to the module will begin on Monday, June 15, 2015
- Students will be prompted through notification on their to-do-list/myUCF page

How is the Not Anymore Module Removed from my To-Do-List?

- Successful completion of the post-test with a score of 80% or higher (students have a maximum of 3 attempts to successfully pass the program)

Due Date for Not Anymore - Monday, August 24, 2015

Overview: Hazing Prevention, It's Everyone's Responsibility Module

How to Access the Hazing Prevention Module

- Access Date: Monday, May 25, 2015
- Students will be prompted through a notification on their to-do-list/myUCF page:
 - Go to: <http://ucf.prevent.zone>
 - Click on the login now button
 - Students will be asked to login using their UCF credentials
 - Complete the profile section with email address and requested information
 - Student will be asked to complete a short initial survey
 - Student will proceed through each section of the module completing a quiz and final survey
 - Upon completion of the survey, students will receive a certificate of completion
