Greek Council Job Descriptions

Student-At-Large

The Student-At-Large (SAL) Position is meant for students who are unaffiliated with the Social Greek System. The SAL is a representative of the entire student body who is responsible for providing input and advisement to the Greek Council. The SAL is a voting member of the Greek Council and is thus able to impact and influence the direction that the Social Greek System at UCF moves.

The requirements for becoming the SAL are as follows:

- Must be an Activity and Service Fee Paying Student
- Must be enrolled in at least six (6) credit hours as an undergraduate degree-seeking student or a post-baccalaureate student, or at least five (5) credit hours in a graduate degree-seeking program.
- Have a minimum overall grade point average of 2.75
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined in the current Undergraduate Catalog or Graduate Catalog of UCF
- Be in good academic and disciplinary standing
- Be Free of any holds on university records
- Must not be affiliated with any of the Social Greek Chapters at UCF
- Complete Interview with the Greek Council President and the Director of Fraternity and Sorority Life.

Persons seeking this position should have a strong sense of unity and be committed to the overall advancement of UCF and its Greek Community. In addition, they must be willing to spend time planning, organizing, meeting with officers, working well with various university members (administrators, students and staff), holding office hours in the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life, as well as holding weekly meetings with OFSL advisors.
