



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHO CAN UTILIZE THE PANTRY?

The Knights Helping Knights Pantry is an initiative to help students in need. Students just need to provide a Student ID to utilize the pantry.

ARE THERE LIMITATIONS TO WHAT STUDENTS CAN TAKE?

Students are permitted up to 5 food items per day. There is no limit on toiletries and clothing.

DO STUDENTS HAVE TO APPLY OR PAY FOR SERVICES?

No. Students can stop by at any time if they are in need.

WHAT ARE THE PROCEDURES FOR USING THE PANTRY?

- Have your UCF ID ready when you arrive.
- If you are picking up food, step up to a scale to have your items weighed. There is a 5 food item daily limit.
- Complete a survey at one of our computer stations. Please only complete one survey per semester.
- Students are welcome to use the microwave and utensils at the pantry to heat/prepare their food.

WHO RUNS THE KNIGHTS PANTRY?

The Knights Pantry is supported by the UCF Student Union and the Student Government Association. In addition to volunteers, the pantry is managed by a Student Outreach Coordinator and a Student Pantry Manager.
